

Hillsboro City Council Special Meeting
August 16, 2010

Mayor Baran called the Meeting to order at 12:00 noon.

Roll call was taken and those present were Mayor Baran and Commissioners Hill and McCammack.

Mayor Baran informed the Council that Commissioner Sherer has asked to attend the meeting electronically and asked if there was any opposition.

There was no opposition so Commissioner Sherer was called along with City Attorney Cullen so they could attend the meeting.

Mayor Baran discussed the job posting and noted there were issues with the laborers' union concerning some of the job descriptions. Mayor Baran also noted that City Attorney Cullen had suggested omitting much of the "supervisor" language.

Commissioner Sherer noted that he wanted the job to reflect what any other union employee might encounter in the absence of an immediate supervisor.

Mayor Baran called for a recess so that union stewards could review the changes as submitted by the City Attorney. During the recess Commissioner Trost arrived and was able to attend the remainder of the meeting. After the 15 minute recess union representatives wanted the description revised further.

Motion was made by Commissioner Sherer and seconded by Commissioner Hill to resubmit the job opening as would be revised by the City Attorney. Motion carried 4-1 with Commissioner Sherer voting no.

Mayor Baran stated he would like the union to review the updated posting after it is prepared.

Motion to adjourn was made at 12:45 by Commissioner Hill and seconded by Commissioner Trost. Motion carried 5-0.
