

City of Hillsboro Special Council Meeting
December 14, 2010

Mayor Baran called the meeting to order at 6:45 pm.

Roll call was taken and those present were Mayor Baran and Commissioners Trost, Hill and McCammack.

Mayor Baran introduced Mike Cavanaugh of the West Central Development Council who was there to present the Council with possible grant funding opportunities.

Mr. Cavanaugh stated that due to "Hurricane Ike" there was an opportunity to seek grant funds to recoup expenses that have been spent related to the heavy rains associated with the hurricane. There would be no "match" from the City necessary although it could help the City's chances for funding. There was also no need for a public hearing to pursue this grant.

The City could also decide to pursue other grant options for infrastructure through DECEO and these would need an income survey and a public hearing to begin the process for funding.

Mayor Baran thanked Mr. Cavanaugh for his presentation and asked the Council to consider these options as the submittal time for "Hurricane Ike" is the middle of January.

Motion to adjourn was made at 6:59 by Commissioner Trost and seconded by Commissioner Hill. Motion carried 4-0.
