

Hillsboro City Council Meeting
December 27, 2006

Mayor Baran called the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m.

Roll call was taken and those present were Mayor Baran and Commissioners Trost, McCammack, Hill, and Richmond.

Mayor Baran asked to appoint Cheryl Whitten, as acting City Clerk, for this meeting, in the absence of City Clerk David Booher, who was on vacation.

Motion was made by Commissioner Richmond and seconded by Commissioner McCammack to appoint Cheryl Whitten as acting City Clerk for this meeting. Motion carried 5-0.

Mayor Baran requested council approval of the sale price for city owned land at Welch Street and Ash Street to Randy Keiser, which was sold at a public auction on December 13, 2006, for \$11,000.00.

Motion was made by Commissioner McCammack and seconded by Commissioner Hill to adopt *Ordinance # 1452* approving the bid price of \$11,000.00, from Randy Keiser for the purchase of city owned property at Welch St. and Ash St. Motion carried 5-0.

Commissioner Richmond requested council approval to purchase three new-style light bars for the Police Dept. squad cars. He said the early purchase would save the City \$1,000.00 per light bar if purchased before the end of the year. Total estimated would be \$6,285.00, paid for from the police department's rural fund.

Motion was made by Commissioner Richmond and seconded by Commissioner Hill to purchase three new-style light bars for the police department at an estimated total of \$6,285.00. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made at 11:08 a.m. by Commissioner McCammack and seconded by Commissioner Richmond. Motions carried 5-0.
