

Hillsboro City Council Meeting  
Special Meeting  
July 1, 2008

Mayor Baran opened the meeting at 6:07 pm.

Roll call was taken and those present were Mayor Baran and Commissioners Trost, Hill, McCammack and Sherer.

Sam Whitlow led the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Baran informed the Council that he had two resignations from the Auxiliary Police Department that needed Council action. One was from current Chief, Sam Whitlow and the other from Barb Whitlow.

**Motion was made by Commissioner Sherer** and seconded by Commissioner Hill to accept the resignations of Sam and Barb Whitlow from the Auxiliary Police Department effective June 30<sup>th</sup>. Motion carried 5-0.

Mayor Baran then presented a plaque of recognition to Sam Whitlow for his over 20 years of service to the Auxiliary Police Department and 8 years as Chief. A certificate of recognition was also presented to Barb Whitlow for her years of service.

Mayor Baran, upon the recommendations of the Hillsboro Police Department, asked the Council to approve Jeff Knodle as the new Chief of the Hillsboro Auxiliary Police Department.

**Motion was made by Commissioner Sherer** and seconded by Commissioner McCammack to approve the appointment of Jeff Knodle as the new Hillsboro Auxiliary Police Department Chief. Motion carried 5-0.

Mayor Baran gave the "oath of office" to newly appointed Chief Knodle and to John Unger appointed at the last meeting as a Lake Patrol Officer.

**Motion was made by Commissioner Hill** and seconded by Commissioner McCammack at 6:19 pm to go into closed session to review minutes of previous closed sessions to determine what could be released to the public. Motion carried 5-0.

Mayor Baran informed the audience that there would be no further decisions made after the closed session.

Mayor Baran reconvened the regular meeting at 7:07 pm.

Roll call was taken and those present were Mayor Baran and Commissioners Trost, Hill, McCammack and Sherer.

Motion to adjourn was made at 7:08 pm by Commissioner Trost and seconded by Commissioner Sherer. Motion carried 5-0.
