

Hillsboro City Council Meeting
Seating of New Council
May 8, 2007

Judge Kelly Long was present and administered the Oath of Office to the incoming Council.

Mayor Baran called the meeting to order at 7:35.

Roll call was taken and those present were Mayor Baran and Commissioners Trost, Hill, McCammack and Sherer.

Mayor Baran thanked Judge Long for swearing in the new Council.

Mayor Baran informed every one of his recommendations for Council departments. His recommendations were Commissioner Trost to remain as accounts and finances, Commissioner McCammack to remain at public works, Commissioner Hill as health and safety and Commissioner Sherer as public property.

Mayor Baran asked for a vote of yeas or nays to his appointments. Ayes were given by all Commissioners in the following order; Commissioners Trost, McCammack, Hill and Sherer.

Mayor Baran also stated that Commissioner Hill would remain on the Natural Resource Committee along with incoming Commissioner Sherer.

Council remarks;

Commissioner McCammack stated he is looking forward to the next four years and getting the new water treatment plant online.

Commissioner Trost stated it had been great working with the previous Council.

Commissioner Sherer stated he was honored and humbled at being elected to the office and was looking forward to the next four years.

Commissioner Hill announced she has had a great working relationship with her past department and she had a lot to learn in her new position, but would do the office proud.

Mayor Baran stated the key to a successful government is communication and the help of the various committee volunteers.

Mayor Baran next announced there would be a special meeting on May 15th that would immediately go into closed session to discuss personnel. After the executive session there will be no decisions made. Appointments of salaried personnel would be at the last meeting in May.

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made at 7:38 by Commissioner Sherer and seconded by Commissioner McCammack. Motion carried 5-0.
